NEXT LEVEL BOWHUNTING WORKSHOP Class Descriptions

<u>Preparation before the Hunt</u>: Covers the preparations one must take before you go into the field for a bow hunt. This includes dressing appropriately for the weather, physical conditioning, the basics of shooting a bow, judging distances, discussion of Virginia Hunting Regulations, knowledge and behavior of your quarry and scouting the area you will be hunting in.

<u>Bowhunting Methods:</u> Discusses specific Bowhunting techniques including the use of elevated stands, ground blinds, still hunting, glassing & stalking, scent control, the effective use of lures cover scents, game calls and camouflage techniques.

<u>Shot Placement & Recovery Techniques:</u> Covers shot placement and game recovery. How a broadhead actually harvests game, shot strategy, how shots go wrong, recovery of the game after the shot, field dressing and transporting harvested game.

<u>Outdoor Preparedness</u>: Discusses the hazards of hunting, developing a hunt plan, basic first aid, survival and a brief review of map & compass, GPS skills.

<u>Field Exercises</u>: Participants will get hands on experience with tracking and blood trailing techniques for harvested game, scouting a hunting area to identify feeding and bedding areas, treestand or blind placement, and an actual hunt on a Wildlife Management Area.
