- 11" 3 ply maple shell with a Remo frosted head
- Kershner tailpiece
- ¼" round tone ring
- 24 notched tension hoop with L shoe brackets and banjo bracket hooks
- The neck is a Honduran Mahogany with a two way adjustable truss rod
- Ebony fingerboard with side position markers and pearl dot inlays
- There are two Brass coordinator rods for neck attachment to the shell

Workshop Line-Up

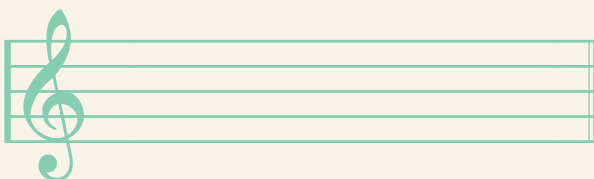
- Workshop starts with check in at 4:00 PM on Sunday April 14.
