Workshop Info

- Weave cotton placemats or a table runner.
- Choose one of several patterns: Color-and-Weave, including Shadow Weave and Log Cabin, plaid, twill, or stripes.
- Color-and-Weave is a method of making designs using two or more colors interacting with the weave structure.
- Begin with a naked loom, and learn to dress the loom for weaving.
- Unique offering uses two types of looms: 4-shaft or rigid heddle.
- Loom preference will be selected by order of class registration.
- Shaft looms available for rental, rent-to-own, or sale after class, if desired.
- No experience required. A selection of different projects will help everyone succeed.
- Small class size; limit of 12 students.

Price includes loom and weaving tool use, yarn, expert instruction, meals, and lodging.
